

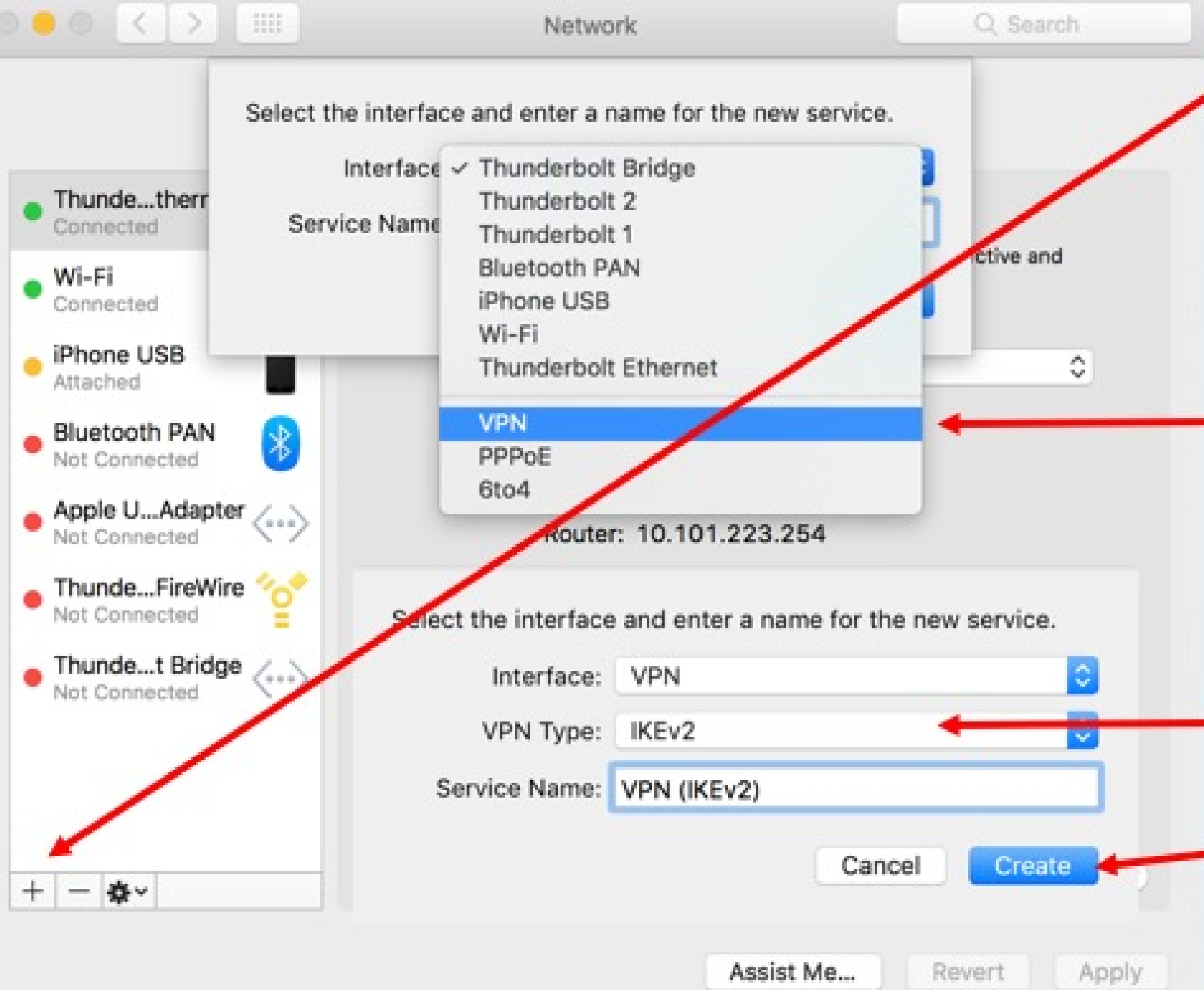
Open System Preferences.
